- 4.8 years younger population

















































































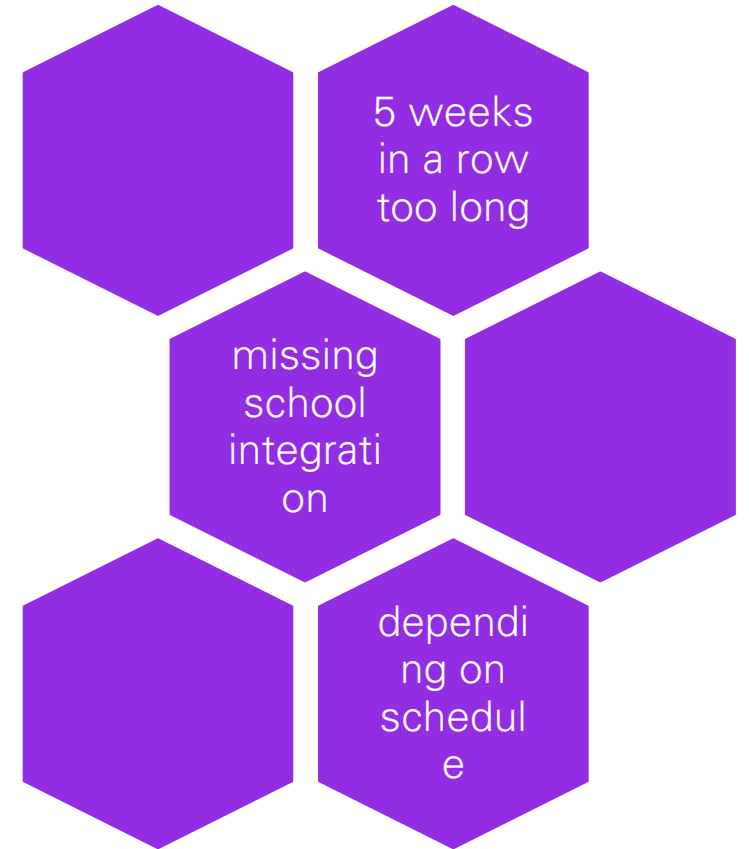
